Propane (At Home Or Work) - Overlooked Danger

Beautiful day in May. I worked on the site as a field safety. Forklift operator promptly drove forklift from the warehouse to the outside location to change Propane cylinder. He was so relaxed (perfect weather), that he lighted his cigarettes and was about to undo hoses from Propane cylinder to change nearly empty to the full one.

I think I establish my personal track record in running speed (I was quite good on short distance running many years ago), even running in the heavy safety boots. When I was close to him, I yelled STOP. I think I overdo the level, as everybody in 50 meters radius stopped whatsoever they were doing and frozen. I probably saved worker from being badly burned (at least) or blown up by propane from the hoses or cylinder.

Companies have procedures and policies regarding fueling vehicles and equipment, but very often there is nothing regarding Propane, which is more flammable or explosive than gasoline. Quite often I observed Propane cylinders being exchanged inside of the buildings.

The same caution with Propane applied at work, should be applied at home, when we fire up barbecue, or exchange barbecue Propane cylinder.

A hint - To check if there are any leaks from Propane connection hoses - spray them with soapy water. If there is a leak - you will see bubbles.
